Job Description

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

The WWTP Operator performs skilled work in the operation of the Integra Water Madison County LLC Wastewater Treatment Facility. Employee monitors and makes prescribed analysis as plant requires determining the proper approach to treatment. Keeps records of lab analysis data; makes reports and the calculations to proper reporting agencies as required. Operates chemical feeders, pumps, aerators, etc to obtain the best wastewater treatment by the most economical means. The employee is under the direct supervision of the Manager of Integra Water, LLC. The current position is classified as Non-exempt for the purposes of the Fair Labor Standards Act, and as having reasonably foreseeable occupational exposure to blood borne pathogens. As Safety Sensitive, the employee is subject to pre-employment, reasonable suspicion, post-accident (incident), random, promotion and transfer, return-to-duty and follow-up drug and alcohol testing. The employee is subject to a pre-employment, post-offer physical abilities test and examination with a written statement from the physician as to the employee's ability to meet the physical strength and dexterity requirements of the position.

QUALIFICATIONS AND EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

- Employee must possess a high school diploma or equivalent, valid Alabama driver's license, Alabama Grade III Wastewater Operator Certificate, and a minimum of three years experience in operation and management of a Grade III Wastewater Treatment Plant. Additional certification of an Alabama Grade II Water Operator would be a plus with possible additional salary compensation

PREFERRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES

- Must have the ability to read, write, comprehend English (operational, process, safety and quality instructions).
- Must possess a high level of analytical, laboratory, and mathematical abilities
- Considerable knowledge of standard laboratory principles, techniques, equipment and materials
- Capacity to work independently under stringent policies, laws, and guidelines.
- Maintain records in an orderly form as required by management and/or regulatory agencies
- Must have a high level of computer literacy with proficient skills in Microsoft Excel
- Must have strong people skills (capacity to communicate at a variety of levels with people in the organization, employees, customers, and associated regulatory agencies – ADEM, EPA, etc).
- Considerable knowledge of the occupational hazards of wastewater treatment and the necessary safety precautions of the treatment facility
- Performs inspections and becomes proficient at mechanical troubleshooting to determine repairs needed on equipment
- Performs routine lubrication, adjustments, minor repair and preventative maintenance on machines and related equipment which may include pumps, engines, centrifuges, generators, valves, gates, mixers, conveyors, blowers, dryers, chemical feed, odor control, disinfection equipment, vacuum filters and belt presses

- Reports operational problems with machines or facility equipment to the Manager
- Oversees facility maintenance including cleaning equipment and grounds as required and dispose of waste according to safety and environmental policies.

PHYSICAL DEMANDS

- The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job.
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is occasionally required to stand, walk, use hands to finger, handle, feel or operate objects, tools, or controls; and reach with hands and arms. The employee is occasionally required to sit, climb, or balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl; talk or hear.
- The employee must occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 lbs. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth perception and the ability to adjust focus.

WORK ENVIRONMENT

- The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those an employee encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. Reasonable accommodations may be made to enable individuals with disabilities to perform the essential functions.
- While performing the duties of this job, the employee is exposed to indoor and outside weather conditions, may work near moving mechanical parts, moderate noise levels, and having reasonably foreseeable occupational exposure to blood borne pathogens.
